January 2026 Meeting Minutes

January 22, 2026

I. Call to Order

The meeting was officially **called to order** by the Chair, Susan Thacker.

II. Approval of the Consent Agenda

A motion was made by Linda to accept the consent agenda with several specific additions proposed by Rebecca Lamb. These additions included:

- The inclusion of Jennifer Brown in the minutes.
- A discussion regarding winter hours at certain locations due to lighting and safety concerns for staff.
- Information regarding the system-wide reclassification and cataloging of non-fiction books. The motion to accept the consent agenda with these petitions was seconded by Susan and approved.

III. Introductions and Attendance

The board and attendees introduced themselves to the new board members and new director:

IV. Friends of the Library Report

Kathleen Cavender provided an update on the Friends' activities:

- **Budget:** The 2026 budget was approved at **\$34,660**, which includes \$600 to VALLA (Virginia Library Leadership Academy) for leadership training in honor of Natalie, an alumni of the program.

- **Feasibility Study:** The Friends voted to pay \$3,000 to Balzar Associates for a feasibility study of the Fishersville basement to determine potential renovations.
- **New Officers:** Jennifer Brown has been appointed as the new Treasurer, succeeding Oakley Pearson, and Susan Miller has taken over as Secretary.
- **Liaison Appointment:** Linda Mohler volunteered to serve as the board liaison to the Friends of the Library for their quarterly meetings. Lisa Nanni-Messegee volunteered to attend in Linda's absence.

V. Director's Report

Natalie Hutchinson presented the monthly report, highlighting the following:

- **Staffing and Redundancy:** Following the retirement of the bookkeeper, Pam, Natalie emphasized the need for cross-training and creating "redundancies" within management so the organization can function if a key staff member is absent.
- **Facilities:** A significant safety issue was identified in Middlebrook, where the floor near the entrance is caving in over a crawl space. Temporary measures have been taken, but long-term advocacy for repairs is needed.
- **System Collaboration:** Natalie is working with directors in Staunton and Waynesboro to streamline the shared catalog and weeding processes.
- **Technology and Grants:** Efforts are underway to clean up the Google Shared Drive and create a more accessible internal knowledge base. The library is also pursuing grants for adult literacy and outdoor spaces, such as a potential playground at Fishersville.
- **Programming:** The "Cat Storytime" program at the animal shelter is continuing monthly after its initial success. Additionally, the "Lucy" book project is moving forward, with 3D-printed Lucy dinosaur models being created for fundraising.

VI. Unfinished Business

- **Search Committee:** The business of the Director Search Committee was officially concluded after Rebecca sent letters to all applicants and the press release was issued.
- **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):** The board discussed a draft MOU with the Friends of the Library. Concerns were raised regarding specific language about office space obligations and advanced notification for program cancellations.
 - Board members felt this was impractical because programs are often canceled last minute due to weather or speaker issues.



- Board members were uncomfortable putting these specific facility obligations in writing as a long-term commitment the library might not be able to honor.
- Because the version in the packet was outdated and highlighted, Linda made a **motion to table** the MOU until the next meeting to allow for a review of the correct draft and potential legal consultation. Catharine seconded and it was approved. Kathleen will send out the most up to date version for the board to review.

VII. New Business

- **Board of Supervisors Liaison:** It was noted that the Board of Supervisors pulled all liaisons from county boards several years ago and no longer wishes to have a representative present at these meetings.
- **2026 Meeting Schedule:** The board discussed moving the meeting time but ultimately decided to keep it at **6:00 PM on the fourth Thursday** of the month for now.
- **Location Rotation:** The board agreed to continue rotating meeting locations among the branches to better understand facility needs. The director will send out a list of locations and dates for the rest of the year.

VIII. Adjournment

The next meeting is scheduled for **March 26, 2026, at the Weyers Cave**. Linda made a motion to adjourn, Rebecca seconded, and it was unanimously approved.

Secretary

Programs and Community Engagement Division

Our foundational services remain strong, with **24 storytime sessions** reaching over 500 attendees across five branches. Our weekly program for **adults with intellectual disabilities** at Fishersville continues to be a cornerstone of our mission, averaging 40 engaged participants per session.



We also hosted a diverse array of specialized events, including:

- **Cultural Education:** Performances by the **Tapestry Quartet** (Traditional Irish Music) and history presentations on **Eastern Woodland Indians** by the **Frontier Culture Museum**.
- **Practical Workshops:** Educational sessions on obituary writing with **Hospice of the Piedmont** and local history with the **Augusta County Genealogical Society**.
- **Monthly Favorites:** Consistent engagement through LEGO clubs, technology literacy classes, and "Read to a Therapy Dog."

Our collaboration with the **SAW Animal Shelter** continues with "**Cat Storytime**," allowing readers of all abilities to practice their skills with feline companions. The **Augusta Health Mobile Clinic** continues to utilize three of our locations monthly to provide vital healthcare access.



March transformed our branches into galleries for **Youth Art Month**. In partnership with **Augusta County Public Schools**, student artwork is currently on display at our Fishersville, Churchville, Middlebrook, Stuarts Draft, and Weyers Cave locations. The opening receptions were a resounding success, drawing families and art enthusiasts alike.

Finally, we are thrilled to celebrate **Keith Bell**, our Programs & Adult Engagement Librarian, who received the **Emerging Leader Award** from the **Greater Augusta Regional Chamber of Commerce**. This honor reflects Keith's exceptional work in building the local partnerships that make these programs possible.



Public Services Division

Our team is growing! We interviewed six talented candidates, securing a new hire and building a strong list of interested substitutes for **Weyers Cave**. Alice is thriving as the **Weyers Cave** Station Manager, and a recent "Dubai Chocolate" Library Lab with Ben saw a sweet uptick in attendance. Meanwhile, in **Middlebrook**, the library is looking sharp with a newly repaired floor. Armed with a new laptop, Tonalay and Aubrey are already brainstorming an ambitious summer lineup, coming off the heels of a massive **Riverheads Elementary Art Show** that drew 144 visitors.



Despite heavy February rains causing minor seepage, **Stuarts Draft** was quickly restored by remediation pros and went on to host a successful first **Youth Art Night** with 64 participants. In **Churchville**, the heart of our mission was on full display as an 81-year-old patron and their child spent the afternoon giggling through crafts, leaving with a warm "Thank you for everything."

Craigsville continues to be a regional anchor. We've welcomed new families and are proud to support "reading circles" as far as Warm Springs over the mountain and Goshen Library, providing book club materials to areas that otherwise lack them. Just two more examples of how **Augusta County** libraries support other areas of our Commonwealth.

In **Deerfield**, not even a long snow closure could keep people away; once the lot was cleared, patrons immediately returned for book clubs and a surprise pop-up children's program.

At Fishersville, it's been a season of mentorship and transition. We wrapped up a successful internship with a **Woodrow Wilson Workforce** student and are now planning our **Volunteer Luncheon** for May 8.

Doug has officially stepped into his role as Branch Manager, navigating his new responsibilities and team delegation. Behind the scenes, we are keeping operations tight—managing accounting tasks and preparing for the upcoming **Station Managers meeting** on April 17—to ensure every branch has the support they need to shine.

Library Administration

Fiscal & Operational Management

We have successfully finalized the FY2027 budget, with a welcome increase in state aid to \$265,048. To streamline operations, we launched a new janitorial contract with Cintas for the Fishersville branch and implemented a more efficient daily financial reconciliation process for management staff. Additionally, our Work Expectations Committee is currently redesigning desk hours and service standards to ensure a uniform, high-quality experience across the entire system.

Infrastructure & Technology

We are leveraging E-Rate to significantly boost internet speeds and bandwidth at all locations. While evaluating our hardware, we discovered our current copiers were often five years old upon arrival—leading to 20+ hours of lost staff time in repairs this month alone. Moving forward, we are upgrading to modern units to better serve our high-traffic areas. On the digital front, we simplified our statistics recording (Gimlet) to a "tick-mark" system; this change has already increased recorded engagement while freeing staff to focus entirely on the patrons in front of them. Fishersville is piloting SPOT Global Printing to give patrons a new way to print from their phones.

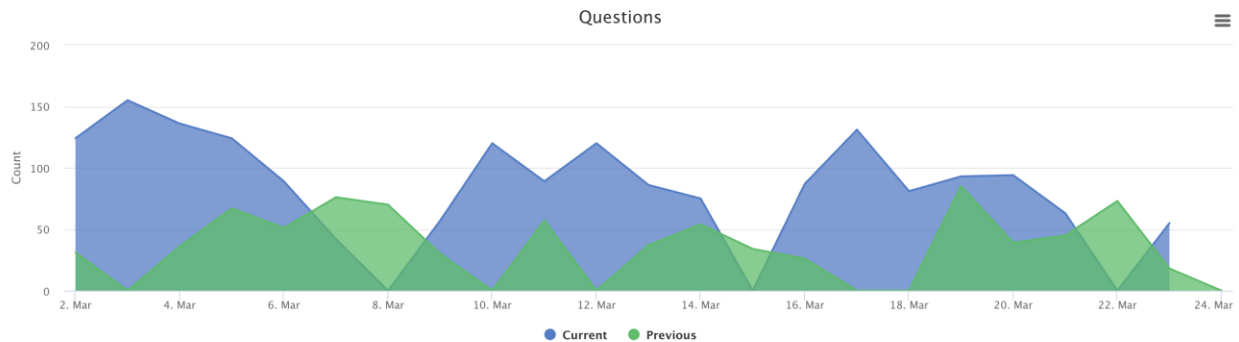

Our team continues to strengthen with the hiring of a new Accounting Technician and a Weyers Cave Station Manager. We also partnered with County HR to establish a new Grade 18 substitute pool to ensure seamless coverage during leave and major events. To fund future innovations, we have submitted four grant applications to The Hershey Company, Dominion Energy, and Dollar General.

Innovation remains a priority:

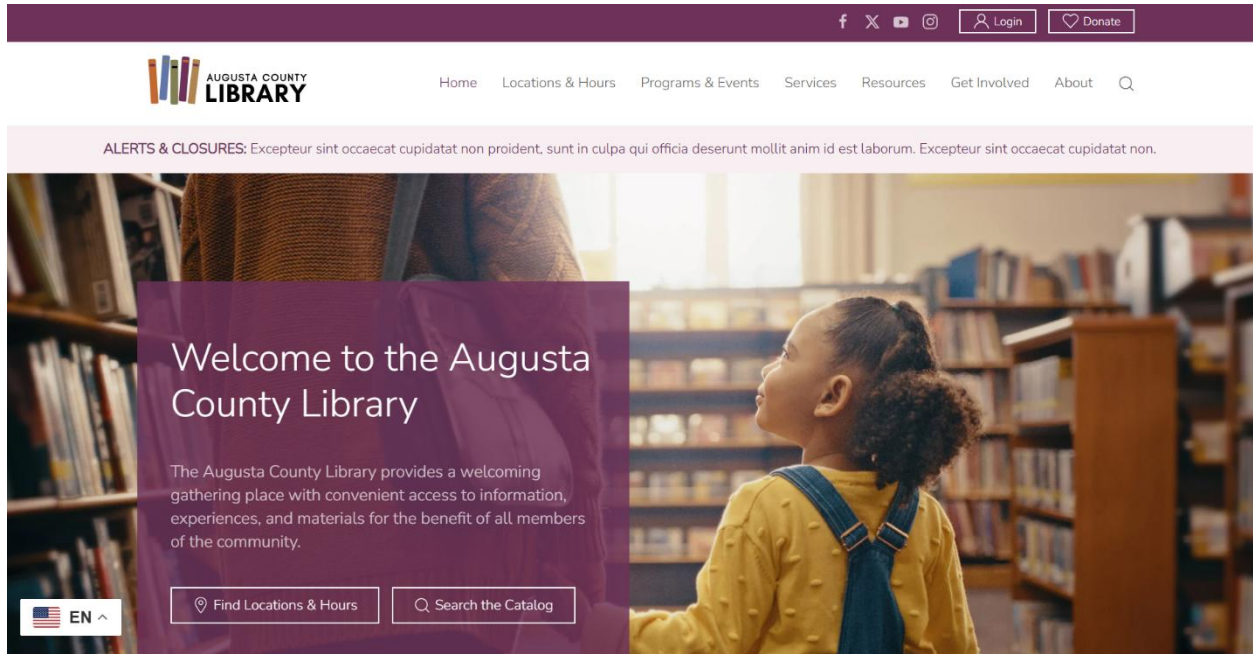

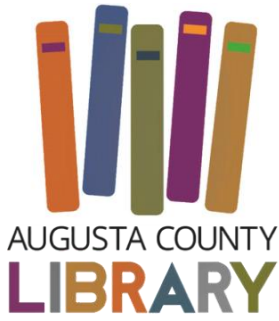
